



Patient Selection Guidelines for the Patient Mastery Program

Patient Selection Criteria

Doctors should be looking for two patients. One patient will be treated in your office and documented. The other patient will be treated in the Esthetic Center. Both patients will be presented in the treatment planning phase of the mastery series and for final evaluation.

The first patient should be a candidate for an anterior implant along with other anterior esthetic considerations.

The second patient should be a complex anterior esthetic case which may or may not contain posterior esthetic considerations.

Participating patients often become advocates for their dentist's office. In addition, when you bring your own patients you have the option of billing for the treatment provided at the Dental School. The school cannot provide patients.

Supplies and Equipment

Most equipment and supplies are provided. A list of supplies that you will need to bring with you to the course can be downloaded on the EDEC Web site.

Dental Laboratory and Assisting Services

You have the option of using your own dental laboratory and bringing your chairside assistant. If requested, we may be able to arrange for a dental assistant and for a dental laboratory technician to work with you as needed. You are responsible to pay for dental assisting and laboratory services separately. Their services are not included in the tuition payment.
